Fa'afetai mo lou fiasia i le Polokalame o A'oga Amata a le Malo o le EOEL . Fa'amolemole faitau fa'amatalaga nei e iloa ai mana'oga agava'a o le polokalama, mana'oga talosaga, ma le fa'agasologa o le taliaina ma le lesitalaina.

E agavaa la'u tama mo lenei polokalame?

Children must be age three or four on or before July 31 of the current school year. Mo le tausaga a'oga 2023 - 2024, o tamaiti na fananau i luga pe i le va o Aukuso 1, 2018 - Iulai 31, 2020, e agava'a. I le fa'aopopoga i le tausaga e mana'omia, fa'amolemole va'ai vaega o le fa'amuumua mo le taliaina i totonu o le polokalame i le itulau e 3 (Fa'afea ona agava'a tamaiti mo le polokalame?).

O afea e mafai ai ona lafoina ai tusi talosaga?

E mafai ona tu'uina atu tusi talosaga i a'oga amata ia Mati 1, 2023 (June 1, 2023 for NEW DOE Schools). Fa'amolemole ia maitau o talosaga e tatau ona tu'uina atu i lo latou ato'aga ina ia filifili ai mo le agava'a. O afifi e le atoatoa o le a toe fa'afo'i ma e tatau ona toe lafoina i lo latou ato'aga.

E to'afia tamaiti o lo'o i totonu o potu a'oga ta'itasi?

O le maualuga ole numera o tamaiti a'oga e lesitalaina i vasega ta'itasi ua fuafuaina i le ata pu'eina fa'ata'afāfā o potu a'oga. Peita'i, e fa'atapula'aina vasega ta'itasi e le sili atu ma le 20 tamaiti a'oga. (O le tele o vasega e mafai ona suia e fa'afetaui i le mana'oga fa'ale-soifua maloloina ma le saogalemu o mana'oga o tamaiti ma le auaigaluega e tula'i mai i tulaga e le'i mafaufauina. Siaki i le a'oga o lo'o e talosaga mo so'o se fa'afouga.)

A o fa'atapula'aina avanoa, ua fautuaina aiga e tu'uina atu le talosaga fa'atumu ma pepa mana'omia i se taimi vave.

O le fea le a'oga o le a ou lafoina ai le talosaga ma pepa e mana'omia?

Fa'atumu ma tu'uina atu le tusi talosaga fa'apipi'i fa'atasi ai ma pepa mana'omia i le a'oga e te mana'o i lau tama e auai i ai (va'ai lisi o a'oga i le itulau 7-8).

E le mana'omia se fa'afanua fa'atulafonoina mo le Polokalame o a'oga faata'ita'i a le Malo EOEL Peita'i, o le fa'amuumua e ave i tamaiti o lo'o talosaga i a latou a'oga i lotofale. O tamaiti nei e nonofo i totonu o le fa'afanua tua'oi o le a'oga. Fa'afeso'ota'i le a'oga lata ane e saili pe o nonofo lou aiga i totonu o le vaega o le a'oga o a'oga i le lotofale.

O le a le mea e tatau ona ou tu'uina atu i le a'oga?

O se afifi atoa e aofia ai pepa uma o lo'o lisiina i le itulau 9 (Lisi Siaki o Talosaga). O le a le taliaina se tusi talosaga e aunoa ma pepa uma e mana'omia. Fa'amolemole fa'apipi'i fo'i se teutusi e fa'atuatusi, fa'amau fa'ailoga ma afifi ta'itasi.

Fa’afefea ona agava’a tamaiti mo le polokalame?

I le fa’aopopoga i tausaga mana’omia, o le fa’amuamua e tu’uina atu i tamaiti o latou tulaga e aofia ai, ae le gata i lea, tasi pe sili atu o mea nei:

- Tamaiti e agava’a mo **auaunaga fa’apitoa a’oa’oga** i lalo o le Tagata Ta’ito’atasi ma Mana’oga Fa’apitoa (IDEA) ma mana’omia le a’oa’oga lautele.
- Tamaiti i totonu **tausiga fai**.
- Tamaiti o lo’o feagai **leai se fale e nofo ai pefale lē mautonu**.

“ Leai se aiga ” o lona uiga o tagata e leai se fale tumau, masani ma lava se nofoaga i le po (i totonu o le uiga o le vaega 42 USCS §11302 (a)(1)) ma aofia ai:

- **Le Malui’a:** E leai se nofoaga masani e nofo ai i le po ma nofo ai i se toluapiga, ta’avale, matafaga/paka, fale tu’ua, auala, po’o seisi lava avanoa e lē lelei ile ola ai.
- **Malutaga Fa’afuase’i:** E nofo i se malutaga fa’afuase’i, fesuia’i po’o se fale puipuia i sauaga i totonu o aiga.
- **Fale Talimalo tele/Fale Talimalo laititi :** Nofo i se faletalimalo tele po’o faletalimalo la’ititi ona o le leai o isi fale talafeagai, **e lē aofia ai** nofoaga lē tumau mo tagata o le militeri o lo’o fa’atali ini fale.
- **Nonofo ma Isi:** E nofo lē tumau ma se aiga po’o isi tagata ona o le leiloa o le fale po’o se fa’aiuga o le faigata o le tamaoaiga.

- Tamaiti **e lua pe tele-gagana o a’oa’o** .
- Tamaiti o lo’o feagai **ma tulaga lamatia** e ono a’afia ai a latou a’oa’oga ma atina’e.
- Aiga e iai Tupe Maua a le Aiga atoa **i tausaga ta’itasi / masina i pe lalo ifo o le 300%** o Ta’iala o le Mativa a le Federale PO’O o latou e mauaina le Fesoasoani Lē Tumau mo A’iga o iai Mana’oga po’o Temporary Assistance for Needy Families(**TANF**) ma/po’o Polokalame o Fesoasoani mo Mea’ai Fa’aopoopo po’o le Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (**SNAP**).

Mo afifi na mauaina ia June 30, 2023 (July 31, 2023 for NEW DOE Schools)

- Tamaiti o lo’o talosaga i le latou a’oga i le lotofale (o lo’o nonofo i totonu o le fa’afanua o lena a’oga) ua lesitala i le fa’asologa lea na mae’a ai talosaga ma pepa uma na mana’omia na mauaina e le a’oga.
- Afai o avanoa pea le avanoa pe a mae’a June 30th (July 31st for NEW DOE Schools), o tamaiti a’oga e le o a’o’oga i le lotofale, e lesitalaina lea i le fa’asologa e maua ai atoa le afifi e le a’oga.
- O a’oga latou te lafoina tusi o le taliaina po’o le te’ena i matua /tausi fa’ale-tulafono. 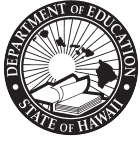

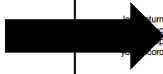
