Clarification and update on Act 156 (SB 2475 SD2 HS2 CD1) - Establishing the Harm to Students Registry: Currently Dept. of Education (DOE), Hawai'i Association of Independent Schools (HAIS), and EOEL are working on implementation. Because the statute refers to education, Dept. of Human Services (DHS) licensed child care programs are not currently required to consult the registry, although they have access. The harm to students registry would have a record of complaints that do not necessarily lead to prosecution and conviction. Fingerprint and criminal history checks reflect convictions. Update: DOE campuses with non-DOE or EOEL early childhood programs are screening those teachers and aides as volunteers on campus. Volunteers are subject to the requirement. 	3:20 - 3:40
