<p><b>EOEL</b> <b>HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE</b> <b><u>Educational Assistant</u></b></p>	<p>In addition to the requirements of the <b>ENGLISH LANGUAGE</b> Educational Assistant above, EOEL Hawaiian Language Educational Assistants must meet one of the following Hawaiian Language competency requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Passing a Hawaiian Language oral proficiency exam at their own expense (e.g., KHAW/HAW 490); or</li> <li>2. Providing a diploma or official transcript that s/he is a graduate of a Kaiapuni High School; or</li> <li>3. Demonstrating completion of 30 semester credit hours* of non-introductory Hawaiian Language courses (beyond 202), including:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 12 semester credit hours* in continuing Hawaiian Language courses (301, 302, 401, and 402);</li> <li>• A minimum of six (6) semester credit hours in Hawaiian language elective courses at the 300-400 level in various content areas; and</li> <li>• The remaining 12 semester credit hours may include non-introductory Hawaiian Knowledge courses to enhance the Hawaiian Language worldview (to be determined on a case-by-case basis).</li> <li>• A transcript analysis will be completed for the 30 acceptable semester credit hours submitted.</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
